

# REMONTOWA

# Peter Wessel

In April 2003 *Peter Wessel* left Remontowa. The ferry was converted for the Norwegian shipowner Color Line.

Norwegian ferry was built in 1981 and in 1988 she was lengthened. She is 168.5 m long and 24 m wide. She takes 2100 passengers and 570 cars on board.

The aim of the conversion is to fulfil the new SOLAS regulations and the regulations of the Stockholm Convention - improving the passengers' safety.

## SCOPE OF WORK

- prefabrication and installation of sponsons of total weight 249 tonnes.
- removal of the part of shell plating i.w.o. sponsons of total weight 158 tonnes.
- prefabrication and installation of a new crew mess in the stern part of total weight 48 tonnes
- modification and installation of new ship systems such as air-condition system (HVAC), sanitary systems, sprinklers' system etc. ensuring higher efficiency necessary on ship after conversion
- exchanging the staircase on decks nr 6, 7 and 8.
